- 1. Your furniture, floors and carpet should be protected with cloth or plastic sheets from start to finish.
- 2. Watermarks, smoke stains, pen marks, and other unsightly blemishes that could bleed through the new paint should be properly primed with an appropriate primer or sealer.
- 3. Any loose paint or other imperfections on wall ceilings and woodwork should be removed by scraping and sanding.
- 4. Cracks and holes in walls and ceilings should be repaired with an appropriate filler, sanded and primed
- 5. Holes in the woodwork should be filled, sanded smooth and primed. Imperfections and damaged areas should be sanded smooth.
- 6. Open joints and gaps should be caulked with an appropriate acrylic gap filler for a cleaner and more finished appearance.
- 7. Glossy surfaces should be dulled with a de-gloss or sanded to ensure proper paint adhesion
- 8. Only quality Material should be used. Only quality materials give the best results and LAST Longer
- 9. The work should be done in a neat and professional manner by skilled craftspeople who are polite friendly and work efficiently
- 10. Of course, excess paint should be removed windows, carpets, floors or anything that is no being painted and the entire area should be clean and tidy
- 11. Waste material, by-products and used solvents should be disposed of safely, properly and in an environmentally responsible manner
- 12. The proper Health and safety procedure and equipment should be employed so that your job can be completed safely
- 13. The contractor should carry appropriate insurance cover
- 14. Touch Up paints should be left of future convenience
